The goal of all changes will be to enhance our already interesting home designs. The specific changes you request will be reviewed as to how they complement other exterior highlights of your home and fit into our beautiful environment, filled with desert fauna, light and shadows.

• If you want to paint your existing door select some paint colors.

• In addition to the garage door, you'll need to have exterior features that tie the new door to the rest of the house. Please consider a variety of things, which can be done such as, but not limited to:

- 1. Matching the garage door surface and color to the front door and/or security door
- 2. Changing the sconces
- 3. Changing the scuppers-roof drains
- 4. Changing the exterior window frames
- 5. Changing courtyard walls and/or gates
- 6. On the homes with the California style roofs, changing the fascia above the garage door and around the front entry area
- 7. Changing the mailbox
