Dear neighbors:

This notice is a “heads up” regarding a recent problem found within our neighborhood. An invasive parasite of some sort has been destructive to some of the cactus in our community. Signs of damage mainly include the cactus turning black and eventually dying off (either whole cactus or parts of). If you have been a victim of such a pest, please make sure to remove the cactus once fully dead and treat the soil with an insecticide to stop further spread. It’s also recommended that the parasite remains secluded from other plant life when transporting, etc.
